Door Prizes: 3 car plaques won by Mary, posters won by Woody and Gordy.

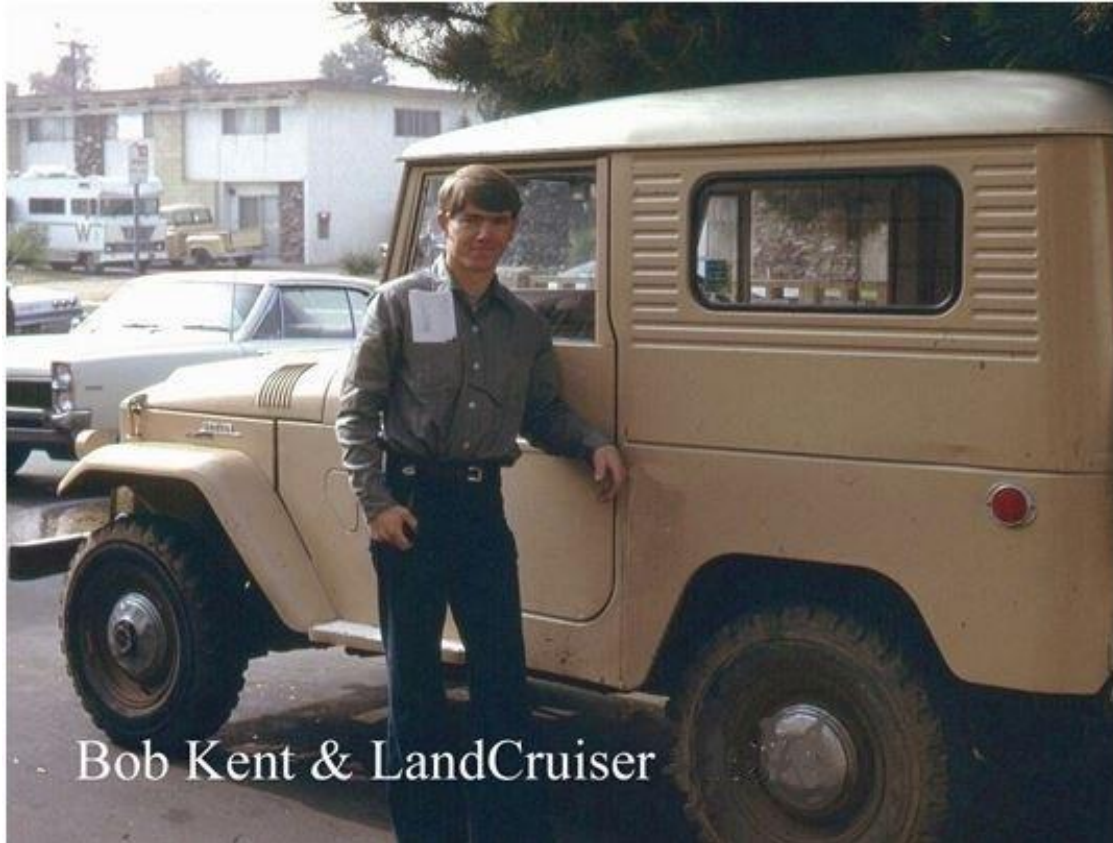
Next Meeting: Will be March 10th at Bob's Cafe. Order from menu. Dinner 6PM, meeting 7PM.
